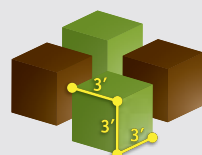

WHAT IS A CUBIC YARD?

One cubic yard is a volume measuring 3 feet wide, 3 feet long, and 3 feet tall. It is equal to 27 cubic feet. Your typical wheelbarrow holds 4-5 cubic feet of material or 1 cubic yard could fill approximately 6-7 wheelbarrow loads. A pickup truck with a 6 foot bed can hold 2-3 CY. An 8 foot bed can hold 3-4 CY.

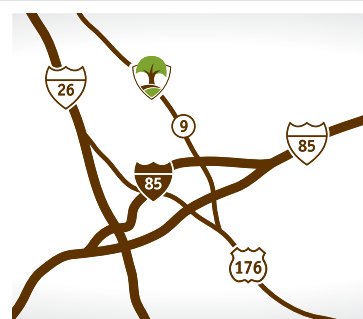

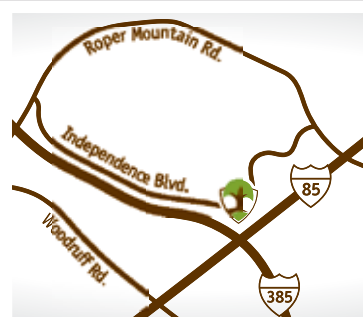

DOUBLE GROUND MULCH

\$20.99/CY

An economy mulch for the cost conscience buyer, this finely ground woody mulch aids in erosion control, weed suppression, and water retention.



SINGLE GROUND HARDWOOD BARK

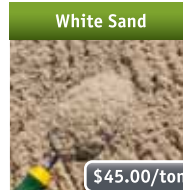
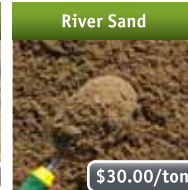

BOULDER

starting at \$170.00/ton

Boulders make a great addition to any landscape. The range in size and shape of these boulders are endless, each one is unique. You will want a machine to move them; they can weigh a couple hundred to a few thousand pounds each. Uses include ponds or waterfall, benches, or centerpieces.



DRystack

starting at \$170.00/ton

Drystack has a thickness ranging from 1" to 6". These rocks are generally used for creating retaining walls. You can even mix in some veneer or thins to create an interesting pattern. These rocks are a great complement to a raised landscape bed.



FLAGSTONE

starting at \$210.00/ton

Flagstone is a durable sedimentary stone that forms thin layers that are perfect for creating patios, walkways, pool decks, stepping stones, & fireplaces. Their large size makes them well suited for all types of paving applications. Colors range from gray, brown, green, and blue.



RIVER ROCK

starting at \$150.00/ton

These rocks have been reshaped and curved over time. Once sharp and jagged, they adorned stream and river for centuries until they transformed into the smooth, round pieces we have today. Dry creek beds and water features are widespread uses of this material. Sizes range from 3" to 14".



STACK

starting at \$180.00/ton

Uses include stacked walls, boarders, fireplaces, edging, columns and even water features. Brown, tans and gray are present on the outside but chip away the outer shell to reveal vibrant reds and pink on the inside. If there is something you can build with rock, chances are you can use these.



STEPPER

starting at \$240.00/ton

These rocks have been battered by the elements giving them a unique, natural appearance. Steppers are rustic and worn stepping stones, irregular in shape. Generally 5" to 10" thick, steppers add an interesting touch to any pathway.



VENEER

starting at \$190.00/ton

Veneer or thin cut stone is ideal for building stacked rock walls, edging for landscape beds, and especially for veneer walls. Thickness of this stone ranges from 3/4" to 1 1/2". Colors include brown, gray, blue, black, green, and burgundy.

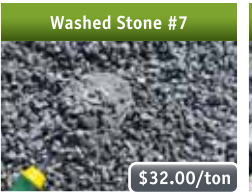
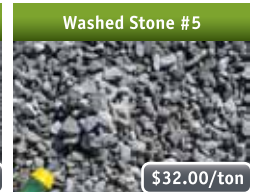
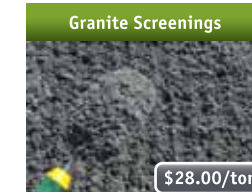

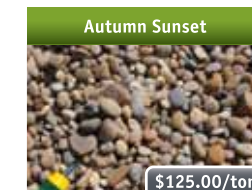
GRANITE STONE

Decorative stone is one of the best ways to add interest and color to any landscape. While many landscapes are dominated by green, these stones add excellent contrast without the need to replenish annually.



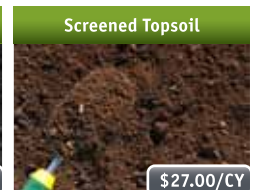
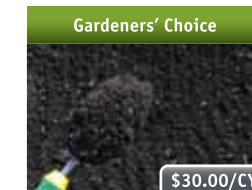
RIVER STONE
